**Conformation**

Conformation classes are judged against the written standard for the "perfect specimen of the breed".

The classes are open to dogs and bitches that are at least six months old. These are the classes in which championship points are awarded.

Once a year the Australian Cattle Dog Club of America bestows top honors to the dog named National Specialty Best of Breed.

Other highly sought after titles such as Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Award of Merit winner and Best of Winners, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are also awarded on this day.

Junior Showmanship is for handlers aged 10-18 years. The judging is based on the handling abilities of the junior – including his/her relationship with and training of the dog.

**Puppy Sweepstakes**

Sweepstakes Classes are for young dogs (6-21 mos). They are judged against the same breed standard as used in regular conformation classes.

Dogs and bitches placing in classes receive a percentage of the entry fee for their class and a rosette.

Best Puppy (from the 6-9 or the 9-12 mo. Classes), Best Junior (from the 12-15, 15-18, 19-32 mo. Classes), and the overall or Grand Sweepstakes Winner also receive trophies.

**Veteran Sweepstakes**

Veteran Sweepstakes is for dogs and bitches 7 years and older. They are judged in age classes of 7-10 years (over 7 years-under10) and over 10-years – separated by sex. They are judged against the same breed standard as used in regular conformation classes.

Dogs and bitches placing in classes receive a percentage of the entry fee for their class and a rosette.

The best of the 7-10 year olds, the best of the over 10 year olds, the Grand Sweepstakes Winners also receive trophies.

**Obedience**

Obedience classes test the dog's ability to perform prescribed exercises at three different levels of difficulty. These classes are graded against a theoretically perfect score of 200 points.
